 - o PSC grid decarbonization and gas leaks
 - Engage with the Office of the City Administrator and Office of Budget and Performance Management

 - o Establish a youth climate commission
 - o Form a legislative committee within the DC-CCCR
 - o Form a committee to oversee performance of key District agencies and the implementation of climate-related policies.
